<u>Chronically Homeless</u>: Homeless at least 1 year or homeless four or more times in the last 3 years where the cumulative time homeless is at least 1 year AND possess a documented disabling condition.
<u>Transitional Housing</u>: Project that is designed to provide housing and appropriate supportive services to homeless persons to facilitate movement to independent living within 24 months – longer if approved
<u>Unsheltered</u>: Place not meant for human habitation (under bridge, outdoor encampment, vehicle, park)
<u>Safe Haven</u>: Supportive housing that serves hard-to-reach homeless persons with severe mental illness who come primarily from the streets and have been unable or unwilling to participate in housing or supportive services.



MDHA leads the development of an effective homeless response system that will make the experience of homelessness in Dallas and Collin Counties rare, brief and non-recurring.
